

B.W. Kennedy Memorial Award Presented to Bill Wymenga

One of Bill's specialties lies in his ability to build relationships with national and international partners, lending to an enhanced level of understanding with representatives from both within Canada and with other countries.

If those positions didn't keep him busy enough Bill has also served as the President of the Kent Pork Producers' Association, as a Municipal Councilor in Harwich Township, as Chair of Ontario Swine Improvement and as Chair on the Church Council. As he retires from all of his appointed director positions, Bill is looking forward to spending more time at home helping with the family business and out on the golf course.
